RACE COURSES

Participants will have access to the race course at the competition site beginning at 11 a.m. on the day of the race. Categories, course maps and other information are available here.

RACE FORMAT

Race Format will depend on the number of participants. If less than 40, a Kings Court format will be used (all racers will race 3 times plus qualification round); If more than 40, elimination rounds will be used (Racers are guaranteed one race plus qualification round).

BIB DRAW

- For February 17 Qualification round, Free Style (Skate) race Interval Start, there will be a draw for the starting order using Zone 4.
- For the Sprint Heats Mass Start Results from the qualification round will determine the start order for the following heats.

START TIMES

- Saturday February17 Free Style (Skate) qualifications, Interval start at 13:00.
- Saturday February 17 Sprint Heats start approx. 13:30

BIBS DISTIBUTION

Will be done near the start of the Terrain Park near the Killarney Lake Rotary Lodge.

• Saturday February 17, between 12:00 and 13:00.

Participants must pay a \$60 fee for bibs that are not returned.

WAXING GUIDELINES: NO FLUORO

The Nordiq Canada Fluoro policy will apply for all sanctioned NB Cup. The following will apply for these competitions:

- High Fluoro (HF), Medium Fluoro (MF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes, including HF, MF, or LF powders, pucks, blocks and liquids are NOT permitted.
- Fluoro cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted.
- Fluoro grip powders are NOT permitted.
- Fluoro kick waxes are NOT permitted.

The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, parents, and wax technicians. Keep in mind, non-compliance with this protocol is cheating and contravenes the coaching code of conduct. Coaches and skiers will be held accountable, with appropriate disciplinary action though the NB High Performance Committee, should noncompliance be observed in wax rooms and out on the course. This protocol is in effect at all NB Cups events and at the Maritime Cups.
